Background

This collection consists of paper material related to the activities of the Louisiana National Guard from the 18th century to date. The vertical files were probably established in some form in the 1920s when the library function was established under the auspices of the Adjutant General's Office. In 2005 the vertical files were heavily water damaged by Hurricane Katrina related flooding. The wet files were frozen for a number of months and then dried, cleaned (with dry erase bags?) and re-foldered by Louisiana Binding Service. Much of the material is badly damaged and original order obviously disturbed. An unknown quantity of material was damaged beyond salvage. In 2012 the files were moved from their temporary relocation home at Camp Beauregard to the new museum library at Jackson Barracks and a re-arrangement undertaken per the series list below.

Scope and Content

1718-present (post 1920)

The collection contains biographies, correspondence, pamphlets, newspaper articles, magazines, brochures, orders memorandums, payroll sheets, muster sheets, maps, photos, historical information etc. related to the Louisiana National Guard. The majority of the materials are original documents produced by the offices of the LANG supplemented by a significant portion of material copied from secondary sources.
