Scope and Content

1917-1952

The collection contains documents, objects and publications that belonged to Victor E. Kellner's father, Walter E. Kellner who served with the U.S Navy in World War I. Original arrangement and description of 10 labeled folders/polyester sleeves and 7 unlabeled sleeves conducted by Sherry Pugh, Jackson Barracks Library Archivist, in 1999.
